Raipur, May 17: In its endeavor to make its contribution towards the promotion of excellence and quality teaching of technical institutions, Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Raipur is organizing five days Faculty Development Program for Faculty members under Technical Education Improvement Program (TEQIP) II at VW Canyon during May 20-24, 2019. This is being conducted under the aegis of Ministry of Human Resources and Development (MHRD),

Government of India, which has initiated the third phase of TEQIP for faculty members of higher educational institutes. IIM Raipur has been entrusted by the MHRD with the objectives of highlighting the importance of world class technical education, identifying the gaps and lacunae in the present system, processes and infrastructure and evolving the benchmarks for the delivery of education and resources management. The series of 12 programs is an outcome of learning of two-day conclave organized by Indian Institute of Management Raipur in May 2014. Prof M.Kannadhasan and Prof.

Dhananjay Bapat are programme directors and Prof. Sanjeev Prashar, Dean (Academics) is TEQIP coordinator.

This 8h Faculty Development Program from May 20-24, 2019 will be attended about 45 participants comprising of Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors from engineering colleges across the states of Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, Gujrat, Karnataka, Bihar, Jharkhand, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Madya Pradesh, Odhisha, and Tripura. This Faculty Development Program is centered on various themes, namely Improving governance, Use

of ICT, Vision, Mission and Goal in Academia, Participant Centered learning, Financial system in Academic Institutes, Buidling Team, Accreditation process, Building interpersonal relations, Developing industry interface, Knowledge systems, Funding for R & D projects, Student teacher interaction, Managing Labarotary, Project management, Implementation of GIAN, Procurement Management, Managing stress, and developing global networks. More such programs shall be organized for Faculty Members, Heads of Institutions and Administrative Officials of the Engineering Colleges.
