**Raipur, Aug 18:** In its endeavor to make its contribution towards the promotion of excellence and quality teaching of technical institutions, Indian Institute of Management Raipur is organizing a five-days Faculty Development Program for Faculty members of Chhattisgarh Swami Vivekanand Technical University (CSVTU) Bhilai affiliated Institutions at its newly built Management Development Centre (MDC) at its Campus during August 19-23, 2019.
